This area has been extended for 2008 to include the **Blue Light Zone**. Dedicated to the police, fire and ambulance services, it provides individual forces and associations with the platform to share information on key initiatives.

The Conference explores both strategic and operational techniques of improving co-responding, targeting all ranks of operations and emergency planning.



Day one looks at government policy and how it translates into strategy for various agencies. The day covers lessons learned from specific emergency incidents such as the 2007 summer flooding, 7/7 London suicide bombings and Buncefield, and the insight gained from the Beijing Olympics.

Day two focuses on operational matters and reviews the approach to emergencies of a range of different organisations. These include national and local government bodies, blue light services and commercial service/equipment providers.
